

Using Loom for Pre-recorded Powerpoint Lectures from Lin Yang, Marketing Dept.

Hi Everyone,

Feel free to ignore this email if you are one of the lucky ones not teaching this semester and not dealing with the dumpster fire that is online teaching!

But just in case you're still in search of an effective way to pre-record lectures and/or announcements, I've found Loom to be an incredibly easy way to do it. It allows you to record PowerPoint lectures with a little video of you on the screen which helps students make it more "real" for students. Once you finish recording, it automatically uploads the video to the cloud and creates a link for you to use.

I plan on just using it for announcements and explaining more complicated group assignments, but I can see how it would work well for lectures, too.
